Over the past decade, we have seen U.S. Supreme Court decisions redefining the scope of personal jurisdiction, the passage of the Pennsylvania Fair Share Act providing new limits on joint and several liability, and the demise of the *Azzarello* strict liability scheme in favor of *Tincher*’s practical approach.
